### Notice to Parents/Guardians from Municipality of Langford Setchfield and Treanor Ave - Bike Lane

Bike lanes are protected areas of roadway reserved for the safe passage of cyclists only, and are marked with lines and graphics painted on the road surface.

Aside from being prohibited by the City's Traffic Bylaw, bike lane parking renders the whole lane unusable to cyclists, and creates a hazard, particularly for children as they leave school at this time. The City of Langford Traffic Bylaw prohibits parking of vehicles in a bike lane, with fines of \$100.00 per occurrence or tow-away as required. Patrols of this area are now underway by the City of Langford Bylaw Department and Westshore RCMP, with the goal of improving road conditions and easing congestion at pick-up and

drop-off times. Thank you in advance for your help with this important public safety concern.
