


Jump Rope for Heart Kick Off

Jump Rope for Heart is an organization supporting the Heart and Stroke Foundation. Lakewood School is sponsoring a Skip-a-thon on Friday, May 3rd from 1PM to 2PM to raise money for the Heart and Stroke Foundation. Next Monday April 15th at 2PM we have our Jump Rope Kick Off Assembly. A Jump Rope for Heart envelope will come home following the assembly.

Students are encouraged to collect pledges and return them to their classroom before or on the day of the Skip-a-thon which will be held on the afternoon of Friday, May 3rd. Pledges may



be secured from parents, relatives and friends. For safety reasons, children are discouraged from going door to door. Cheques should be payable to the Heart and Stroke Foundation (tax receipts will be issued for pledges over \$10). On the afternoon of May 3rd we will close the pick-up and drop off zone beginning at lunchtime and reopen it at 2:15pm. Students are reminded to bring labelled water bottles and wear comfortable shoes for skipping. It is important for students to return their pledge forms no later than May 3rd! Parents are welcome to come and join the fun. We are hoping for dry weather for this event. Thanks to Mrs. Penston and the Peer Helpers for once again organizing this wonderful event!

Reunification Drill Next Thursday April 18th at 1:00PM

Lakewood Elementary will be practicing an **Emergency Reunification Drill** to provide students, parents, and staff an opportunity to practice an important component of our school emergency plan. Parents and guardians are requested to participate in the reunification process by following our procedures as outlined below.

It is critical that parents, and alternate guardians understand the school procedures. Student/Parent Reunification Procedures

- Parents/guardians will be directed to the Check-In Gate [1] (next to flagpoles in front of school)
- 2. Arriving parents/guardians will self-sort into alphabetical lines corresponding to the first letter of the family name of the student(s) being picked up.
- 3. A staff member will ask for government issued picture ID (driver's license, military ID, passport, etc.) to confirm the parent/guardian requesting the student(s) is on the <u>Student(s) Release</u> <u>Form</u>, and is authorized to do so. This information was collected in September 2018.
- 4. The staff member will fill out the time and intended destination in the highlighted section of the form.
- The parent/guardian will be asked to sign the appropriate section on the <u>Student(s)</u> <u>Release Form</u>.
- 6. The parent/guardian will then take the bottom portion of the <u>Student(s)</u> <u>Release Form</u> to a staff member at the <u>Release Gate [2]</u> (top of stairs leading to upper soccer field)
- 7. A Runner will take the bottom portion of the <u>Student(s) Release Form</u> to the student holding area.
- 8. Please wait at the Release Gate [2].
- The requested student(s) will be escorted by a staff member to the parent/guardian at the Release Gate [2].
- Once you have the requested student(s), please exit the school grounds to ensure a quick reunification for all families.

Things to Remember

- Bring your government issued picture ID and have it ready at the Check-In Gate [1].
- Send an authorized guardian who is listed on the Earthquake and Emergency Release Form, to pick up your child(ren) during the drill if you are unable to participate.
- Please ensure all authorized guardians are familiar with the school's reunification procedures.

- This will be a slow process, please be patient and respect the importance of accounting for students after an emergency by releasing them under control.
- Use this opportunity to practice your family emergency plan. Please talk to your child(ren) in advance about the exercise, and how they are expected to behave.
- Tell your child(ren) who is prepared to pick them up and care for them after an emergency, or disaster, if you or your spouse/partner can't make it to the school right away.
- Expect traffic congestion at the school, please consider alternate parking areas in the community.
- If you live within walking distance and you are unable to join us for the exercise, your child(ren) will be dismissed as they would normally be at 2:38PM.
