The meeting with administration ensures that your voice will be heard during the configuration process; but in the end, the final decision rests with the teaching professionals. Please ensure that you have read the information about class configuration and multi-grade classes prior to attending the meeting. You will be able to set up an appointment with school administration between May 6th and May 17th. Please contact the office to set up an appointment.
