#### Book Fair Procedures:

-Students and parents will hand sanitize as they are entering the space and as they leave.



-When buying, as much as possible, only touch books that are going to be purchased.

-Parents entering the space will be required to complete the district health check in. A QR code is available to scan to help make this process quicker.

-Parent numbers will be limited to 10-15 people at a time.
