HEALTH CHECK

It is very important that you keep your child at



home if they are sick. We have already had children come to school only to be sent home after being sick at school. If your child cannot pass the health check - do

not send them to school. It is important to, as a family, create a plan for the inevitable day that your child is ill.

FOOD ALLERGIES

There are signs in our school outside your child's classroom indicating that there is a "medical alert" in that classroom. We have students in our school with <u>life-threatening food</u> <u>allergies.</u>



Please make every effort to educate yourself and your child about these allergies and try to send your child with an allergen free lunch every day.

We practice hand washing at school but please have your child wash their hands if they eat these products at home before they come to school. You can help to keep these students safe by celebrating special occasions such as birthdays and Halloween with stickers, games and/or prizes and keeping allergen containing products at home.

Student Cell Phones & Photographs



Student cell phones are becoming common item at our school as they provide safety device for parents and guardians. *We remind students and*

parents that these must be kept in student backpacks throughout the day and are not to be brought out to show friends, play games or make calls throughout the day. Some cell phones also have the capability to take digital pictures. School District Policy prohibits anyone from taking digital pictures of other students without the written permission of that child's parents; therefore, we ask that students,



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and adults, whose phones have this capability, refrain from taking pictures while at school.

Electronic Gadgets/Special Toys

This is a reminder to parents and students that we recommend that: electronic gadgets and other special game cards and toys are kept at

home. It poses a difficult situation for staff and students if one of these items goes missing or is damaged at school, as we often have trouble solving these types



of problems. We encourage students to leave these items at home rather than bringing them to school. We cannot ensure the return of these items if they go missing.
