Principal Report

Treasurer Report

- Total balance as of Feb 29, \$62,936.05
- Revenue: below our revenue goals.
- Important to have the fun fair as it is our main fundraiser activity.

- Bottle drives have been half of what we budgeted.
- Maybe local coupon book that we can charge \$15 and get 50%
- In April have a deep dive into our actuals vs what we budgeted.
- Switched banks from TD to Coast Capital this year. Many other PACs use Coast Capital.
  - It is a 2 signature signing account
  - On a 2 signing account, the debit card does not work
    - This means the Pizza mum has been covering the \$1000 a week pizza buying
- Options:
  - Open a second account that is only 1 signature that \$1000 a week is put into so the pizza mum can buy the pizza
    - It is free to open a second account
    - Unknown if we can have multiple debits cards on the account
    - Membership would be under the PAC
  - Setup a credit account with Panago and pay them via etransfer. Buy costco gift cards to use for juice box/snack purchases
    - Need to contact Panago and see if this in an option
    - Monica P to contact Panago to see if this is an option
  - Will vote at April meeting once we know our options
- Don't see anything in records that we paid SPEAC membership. Liz to double check if we paid or not
- Clubs have budgeted \$500. Karyn asked Kerry to follow up with club leaders if they have any requests as the money is there for them to use
- Hot Lunch renewal is until the end of June. Have to give the admin names at that time.
- Not doing "drop & go" signage
- Treasurer will order new cheques for gaming account

Old Business
