Budget

- Halloween Dance
 - o Dance was successful!
 - Spent \$656.12 of \$1000 budget (excluding janitorial fees) to put on the dance
 - Net fundraising \$2812.13
 - o Increase of \$657.93 over last year
 - Dance had donations of \$729.44
- Donations other
 - Separate donation of \$50
- Bottle Drive
 - Raised \$713.92
 - More than we brought in on previous 2 bottle drives
 - We sorted into 3 categories, which got us an extra 30 cents on the dollar.
 - The bottle drive went well considering the weather

- Reimbursement
 - Cost \$1.50 for each e-transfer
 - Pizza day will continue to be e-transferred as that is a large amount of money each week
 - For other reimbursements we will continue to use cheques and commit to turn around of within 2 weeks for reimbursement
 - Discussion around having a threshold around what should be cheque and what should be e-transfer
 - Hold one off discussion for large purchases on doing an e-transfer
 - Preference to use cheques for lower amounts
 - Spirit wear
 - There are some issues with website
 - Vendor is currently on vacation, but will be back Friday.
 - Hoping to have it resolved for Tuesday Nov 12.
